

English

Fiction: To write own traditional type story based on the plot of "The Whistling Monster" by Jamilla Gavin. Children will create shadow puppets to support their own story writing – linked to our science topic of light.

Non-Fiction: Explanation Text: Musical Instruments.

Poetry:

Including 'Window', 'Rainbows', 'The Sun' and 'The Night is a Big Black Cat'. Exploring imagery and use of simile, metaphor and other figurative devices to 'paint a picture'.

Music

We will be having fun identifying the different creatures and orchestral instruments in the music "Peter and the Wolf". Then we will explore for ourselves how to change pitch and volume and how different sounds are produced by different musical instruments. We will be creating our own musical stories and making our own musical instruments.

Art and DT

Linked to our topic of light, the children will learn how to mix colours to make a colour wheel and learn how to add light and shade to their artwork with an apple sketch. As part of our learning about sound, the children will make their own musical instrument and describe how it works.

PSHE

We will be looking at our learning behaviours and how these can empower our thoughts and wellbeing through the text 'The boy who climbed in to the moon'.
Drugs education – this will be taught in separate year groups.

French

We will be revising greetings such as how you are, what your name is and where you are from.
We will learn colours, numbers and body parts and continue to use French greetings on a day to day basis.

Light and Sound

Maths

We will be learning about fractions and decimals before moving on to perimeter and area. We will continue to progress to the formal methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication. You can help by ensuring your child practices their current times table.

ICT

We will be learning how to insert sound bytes in to a multi-media presentation. The children will then design their own stained glass window using ICT and print this off on to acetate. This will take the theme of Pentecost and light.

Science

Light and Sound

We will investigate light sources, making shadow puppets and exploring translucent, transparent and opaque objects. We will make a sundial and investigate shadow lengths.

The sound element will be taught through music.

RE- Easter

Through art, drama, dance and discussion, the children will:

- Explore what happened after Jesus rose from the dead.
- Learn the story of the Ascension of Jesus into heaven.
- Consider the story of Pentecost.
