GDPR

You may be aware that new legislation surrounding data protection came into effect on 25th May. As a result, this week, your child will have brought home a new Privacy Notice which sets out what sort of personal data we collect, use and store. A copy of this is also on the website. We will be updating our permission request forms, for example, for photographs, etc. for the new school year but, at present, the permissions that you gave at the start of the school year will still apply. However, under the new laws, it must be made clear that you can withdraw permission at any time and a note of this will be included on the new forms. If you wish to withdraw any permissions for holding personal data, please contact the school office.
