This term we will be continuing to learn about Easter and how Jesus is the Risen Lord, exploring the feelings of joy and happiness and recalling the good news of the Easter story.

We will be sharing some of the special ways we celebrated Easter together.

Later in the term we will be learning about Pentecost and how Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to give life and renew us.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term our topic is 'relationships' we will be learning how to share and get along, understanding fairness and why we have rules in school.

We will also be looking at feelings of loneliness and how it feels to be judged through the stories of Rainbow fish and his friends.



Literacy

This term we are looking at non-fiction books on transport. We will be labelling pictures, writing facts and finding out about the first flight.

We will be using the role play area to retell travelling stories such as "Mr Gumpy's Outing" – making puppets and writing speech bubbles.

We will also be writing our very own train ride story after reading the book and going on our own trip.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be making and creating our own modes of transport using junk modelling – if you have any boxes, tubes, lids or bottle tops, please save them and bring them in! We will also be using papier mâché to make hot air balloons and exploring ways of joining materials to achieve a planned effect.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about things that move. We will be finding out about the first train, the Penny Farthing and the first aeroplanes. We are hoping to go on our own train trip from Buckfast to Totnes. We will also be learning about road safety and taking part in some activities led by the charity BRAKE.

On the learnpads, we will be playing phonics games and drawing pictures of cars and buses. We will also be learning directional language and programming the Beebots to move around.

Maths

This term we will be using money to make bus and train fares – please help your child to recognise coins by allowing them to play with money at home.

We will be learning to count in 2's and 10's as well as continuing to count reliably and finding the total of two groups by counting all of them.

We will be making shape transport pictures and exploring 2D and 3D shapes to make trains and cars. We will also be using our new trains to make patterns and sequence and order numbers to 20.
